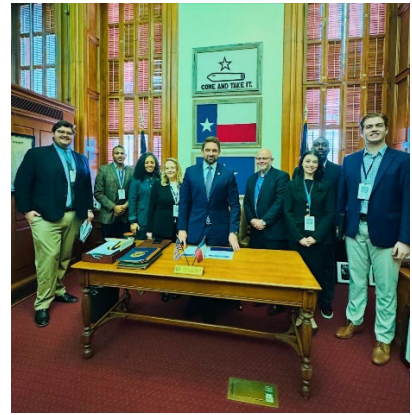


Dear Friends,

This week, I had the privilege of attending the State of the State address with my lovely wife Becky, where Governor Abbott laid out a bold, conservative, and aspirational vision for the 89th Legislative Session and the future of Texas. His address reinforced our shared commitment to providing property tax relief, investing in water infrastructure, increasing teacher pay, educational savings accounts, bail reform and creating the Texas Cyber Command. It was an inspiring call to action, and I am ready to fight for these priorities in the weeks and months ahead.



In addition to hearing the Governor's vision, I've spent the week meeting with constituents, advocacy groups, and community leaders from across our district. These conversations are invaluable as we continue working on legislative solutions that reflect the needs and priorities of the people we serve. Together, we are committed to keeping Texas on the right track.



This week also saw a surge in bill filings, with many important pieces of legislation introduced that will shape the direction of this session. So far, I have filed 18 bills with many more still in the works. Importantly, I filed two bills to help combat the plague of child sexual abuse in our state. [HB 734](#) will increase the criminal penalty for failing to report knowledge of continuous sexual abuse of a child, indecency with a child, sexual assault, trafficking, soliciting or compelling prostitution. Likewise [HB 748](#) prohibits the use of nondisclosure or confidentiality agreements in cases of childhood sexual abuse. It's our responsibility and obligation to everything we can to protect our children from predators and you can be assured that I will be on the front lines doing just that.

Looking ahead, we expect committee assignments to be announced early next week. These assignments will determine where key legislation is debated and advanced, and I look forward to sharing that update with you as soon as it becomes available.

Thank you for staying engaged and for your continued support. As always, my door is open— please don't hesitate to reach out with your thoughts or concerns. Together, we will ensure a strong and prosperous future for Texas.
